



Hi everyone!

Some of you have already heard the good news: we have just achieved world tour of schools around the 192 countries.

We have had excellent French-speaking press coverage in the last weeks, with documentaries broadcasted during the prime time news of 2 main Belgian television channels (**RTBF** and **RTL-TVI**), and on the following radio channels: **France Inter**, **Radio Nostalgie**, and **Radio Judaica**. Some newspapers have also written articles about Art in All of Us: **La Tribune de Bruxelles**, **Belga**, and today 23rd of February, a whole page has been published in **Le Soir** (one of Belgium's main dailies). Another article will soon follow in **L'Évènement**.

We can already feel the results of this press coverage, as many schools and volunteers contact us to either participate to our educational programs, or to support our actions.
